Local Business Owner Completes National Training

Bedford, PA -- Sara Letzo, co-owner of 10/09 Kitchen, recently joined 146 entrepreneurs from 38 states to graduate from a national program designed to help create jobs and stimulate economic opportunity.

The Goldman Sachs 10,000 Small Businesses program provides greater access to education, capital and business support services. Commencing in February 2017, the 11-week program blended intensive online and face-to-face training from business experts and peers.

Campus training took place at Babson College in Wellesley, Massachusetts. Babson has partnered with Goldman Sachs on this program since 2010. The 10,000 Small Businesses program has graduates from over 8,000 businesses located in 50 states, Washington DC, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and the UK.
