Nicole Kruse has gazed out from a lot of Fayette County houses as her family has assembled a portfolio of vacation rentals. The house right between Fallingwater and Ohiopyle set a new bar. "I have never seen one that had a view like that before," she says. "All you see is huge – almost 360 degrees all around you – ridge lines of the mountains." What she calls a "milliondollar view" could be hers for \$250,000. But could she and partner Matt Guess convert it into a profitable rental?
